

1. Solve: $x^4 + 4x^2 = 5$ (Hint: move 5 to LHS first. Also, include any complex solutions.)

2. Solve: $x - 6\sqrt{x} + 8 = 0$

3. Solve: $x^{\frac{2}{3}} + 2x^{\frac{1}{3}} - 3 = 0$

4. Solve: $(x^2 - 2)^2 - (x^2 - 2) = 6$ (Hint: let $u = x^2 - 2$)
